## MENU OF UNBUNDLED SERVICES

### *Divorce Consulting*

We will work with clients from beginning to end, consulting on their case and providing guidance, without filing an appearance with the court. Divorce Consulting includes everything needed in a divorce case except for court appearance. This can include assistance with drafting documents, negotiation guidance, discovery, financial analysis, discovering assets, answering custody and parenting time questions, generating options, negotiation coaching, and drafting final documents. In this role, we guide clients through the process of separation and divorce, and can assist with selecting another attorney to appear in court on the client's behalf, if necessary.

### *Negotiation Coaching*

In this role, we coach clients through the settlement process, guiding them to ensure they have all the necessary, complete information needed to make an informed decision. We answer client questions regarding what is reasonable in their situation, and we generate options to consider during negotiations. In this role, we may prepare memos for negotiations, but we do not prepare official documents.

### *Settlement Agreement or Judgment of Divorce*

We will prepare documents to support an agreement already reached by two parties to complete a settlement or judgment of divorce.

### *Document Preparation*

A client may hire us to prepare documents for use during divorce proceedings. This can include a Dissolution of Marriage Form, a Summons, a Complaint, a Settlement Agreement, a Parenting Plan, Child or Spousal Support Order, and other Orders as needed.

### *Letter Writing*

During a divorce, it may be necessary to write letters to communicate intentions or submit requests. We will do this on behalf of clients, whether the letters are to a spouse, a former spouse, about a particular issue that involves spousal support, child support, parenting time, or custody, or other types of letters needed for a case.

### *Co-Parenting Consultant*

With a demonstrated background in Collaborative Law, we are eager to facilitate discussions between parents and guide clients on questions relating to parenting time. Sometimes divorced parents want to make changes to parenting time, and they would like to consult with an expert on the best way to approach such changes with an ex-spouse. In situations like these, we provide counsel and can even create a letter with ideal language to facilitate the requested change. Sometimes consulting on co-parenting means offering ideas on the best ways to work with the other parent.

### *Collaborative Divorce*
